RAD Camp Medical Staff FAQ

What is the role of the RAD Camp Medical Staff?

At camp, our Medical Staff provides on-site care to all our participants including campers and counselors through administering medication, monitoring, emergency response and first aid.

What are the eligibility requirements?

In order to join our RAD Medical Staff, you must be a registered nurse, licensed vocational nurse, nurse practitioner, physician assistant, or medical doctor with a current, unencumbered, valid California license, possess valid professional liability insurance and hold a current CPR certification. 6 months experience working in the profession is preferred.

Can I still volunteer if I am a student in nursing, PA or medical school?

In order to volunteer as a student, you would need to be supervised. Please have your instructor reach out to Camp@RADCamp.org to speak with the RAD team!

How long is a RAD Medical Staff shift?

There are multiple shifts available at camp varying in length, but typical shifts range from 4 hrs to 12 hrs.

How many shifts can I sign up for?

RAD Medical Staff is encouraged to sign up for as many shifts as they are available for! Our Medical Staff can sign up for shifts at one, two or all three of our sessions!

Where and when does RAD Camp take place?

RAD Camp is held annually at Vanguard University in Costa Mesa, CA. Check out our volunteer page for this year's dates.

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Are RAD Medical Staff Paid?

RAD Camp offers both volunteer and paid positions. We offer an hourly stipend of \$45/hour for those interested in paid positions and are so grateful that 89% of our nurses generously donate their time and talents to camp!

How do I sign up to be a RAD Medical Staff?
